This document contains general instructions for use for SurgiCase Planner. For detailed instructions please refer to the user manual.

DESCRIPTION

The SurgiCase Planner 2.3 is a 3D environment software which allows the surgeon to accurately plan a joint replacement surgery based on MRI, CT or X-ray images of the patient. Based on this approved surgical plan, Materialise will manufacture patient-specific guides that will be used during the surgery, if ordered by the surgeon.

INDICATIONS

The SurgiCase Planner software is intended to be used for simulation of surgical interventions and the planning of preoperational interventions.

The SurgiCase Planner software is used to assist in the positioning of orthopedic components.

CONTRAINDICATIONS

None.

WARNINGS

- The software should be operated by trained personnel, or the output should always be reviewed and approved by a qualified clinician.
- It is the clinician's ultimate obligation to exercise his/her professional judgment in any decision to follow or not follow the treatment plan made using the medical device software.
- Patient specific guides are to be used by a trained clinician in the performance of surgery.
- Be aware that any patient-specific guides and/or anatomical models derived from a planning created in the software have been manufactured based on MRI/CT/X-ray images of the patient. If the patient's anatomy has changed significantly since the time of the MRI/CT/X-ray images, the guides or models should not be used.

PRECAUTIONS

- It is advised to use the guide or model within 6 months of performing the MRI/CT/X-ray images on which they are based. If the patient's anatomy has changed significantly since the time of the

MRI/CT/X-ray images, the guide or model should not be used, even if the time period of 6 months has not expired.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- **Install**
No installation is required to use the SurgiCase Planner. The SurgiCase Planner is a web based application and can be accessed through SurgiCase Online.
- **Start**
To open a case in the SurgiCase Planner, browse to the appropriate case in the SurgiCase Online Ordering System and click the link in the Case Details to open the SurgiCase Planner.
